MAKE YOUR OWN:

Space shuttle picture

This three-dimensional space shuttle picture involves a number of fun and absorbing steps, making it a great 'quiet time' or rainy day activity.

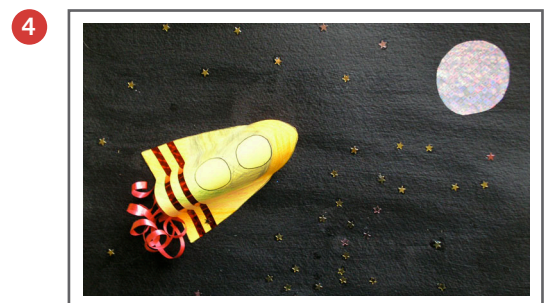
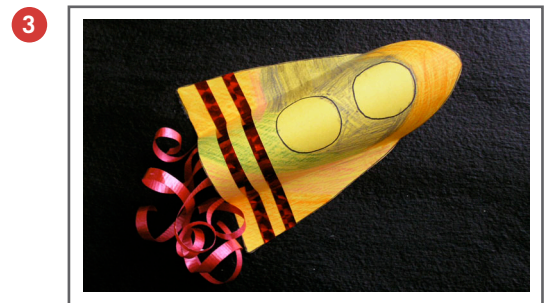
YOU WILL NEED

- this project sheet
- black cardboard
- coloured cardboard
- stars (stickers or glue-on)
- curling ribbon (or cellophane)
- tape
- glue
- scissors

DIRECTIONS

Before you get started you'll need to print the shuttle images onto thin cardboard. You could also print on regular paper – but the end result won't be so sturdy.

- 1 Decorate the shuttle shapes with whatever items you have handy. When you've finished, cut them out and fold in the wings along the dashed line.
- 2 Tape on some curling ribbon to the back of the shuttles to make 'flames'.
- 3 Apply glue to the underside of the wings. Then paste onto black cardboard, forming a cylinder in the process.
- 4 Add stars, planets and other spacecraft as you wish.
